

When Have I Littered?

15. I just buy the artifact and leave it in the woods.
16. I buy a small square of iron and leave it in the woods.
17. I find a rusty piece of iron in a junkyard and leave it in the woods.
18. I find a rusty iron trinket in a junkyard and leave it in the woods.
